

Live 2 Dance Class Rules

Be to class early:

Parents arrive with your dancer 10 min early. Dancer's should use the restroom, wash their hands, be properly dressed & hair already in the proper hair style before class starts. The teachers & assistants have many tasks to do and are not able to be find shoes and fixing hair for students. Shoe borrow bin is in studio B and should only be done at the very beginning of each class.

FYI: As upcoming recital pictures April 2-4 & April 10-13 times and exact dates TBA (studio closed Easter break April 5-9) and performances are fast approaching and all dancers must have their own performance shoes to be rehearsing in! Last date to order shoes is March 14th, see web site for recital picture dates.



Students should be early so they avoid disrupting the class and missing important technique.

Students who are more than 5 minutes late will not be admitted into class. Our facility has 3 studios; studio C dancers must pass thru studio B. Dancers who are late interrupt both classes making the dancers & the teachers lose focus; it is VERY difficult for our younger students to regain focus each time interrupted!

Reason for enforcing this rule:

Our teacher's LOVE teaching your children so please be early to allow dancers to be relaxed and be ready for class, not feel rushed. We know traffic, road conditions, and other extra activities can play a role in tardiness, but teaching your dancer good habits at a younger age makes them great young adults! (If there is an emergency please come to the office and let someone know and they will bring your child into class!)

Be in dress code:

Dancers perform better when dressed for the part, plus instructors are able to clearly see muscle activity and skeletal alignment, as well as unison among dancers. Proper dance attire is part of the tradition and discipline of the art form. All Ballet & Ballet/Combo classes JR, Teen, SPC Ballet; Tiny Tots, Kidz, Pre-JR - Ballet/Jazz & Ballet/Tap classes require girls to have their hair in a bun. Be safe:

Dancers have been known to choke on chewing gum, get cut by jewelry, get injured by lack of warm-up, and get injured worse by not telling the teacher about existing injuries. Please spit out your gum, leave your jewels in your dance bag, stretch before class, bring your dance bag into class and tell the teacher if you are hurt!

Parking lot safety - Parents please remember our younger dancers should be picked up in studio after class, as it is difficult to see younger dancers from your vehicle.

Be respectful:

Dancers work hard to develop beautiful outsides, and we strive to help our dancers develop beautiful insides as well. We expect to hear polite, kind words between classmates and when addressing teachers and parents. We also expect our equipment to be handled with care, and our studio to be treated like the special place that it is.

Be faithful in practicing:

Dancers only improve through repetition; its how their bodies learn to remember the technique and maintain a high level of fitness. The staff has only a short time in the studio with our dancers each week, and we give them the tools to be wonderful dancers. However, it is up to the dancers to use those tools, and what they build depends largely on often they use them!
